Hopefully we will have at least one project per sector group. Prepare for funding via the public sector, then invite investors in district around NSW, Australia and possibly overseas. 3 – 5 year project.

4. **Outline how game works – define community priorities** – 2 minute presentation on each sector
ort, Medium & High priorities – Summary on cards – ranking nbr (1, 2, 3) pick card which is of interest.
5. **How sector groups will be funded** – cost of approx. 2/3rds of what nbrs add up to. Priorities by short, medium, high – short, medium, long term. Example of cards and priorities. Example of overall community priorities.
Arts Foundation – summary from SB – support of the arts – scholarship to a develop artists.
Travel, exhibition, education (no perimeters – for last 8 yrs) would like to support arts more – launching bequest programme. SHYCA, Botanic Gardens & ??? \$\$\$ comes from grants from other parts of the community and country but mainly personal donations. Good at, facilitate smaller Not for Profit groups. Manage their funds to give them tax deductibility.
